**CONSENT ORDER**

The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that M'Lynne Elise Biddle has violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S."). Respondent wishes to resolve this matter and admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. M'Lynne Elise Biddle, ("Respondent") is and was at all material times licensed as a resident insurance producer with lines of authority in life and accident and health or sickness, National Producer Number 18534432, which expires April 30, 2021.

2. Respondent's addresses of record with the Department are: 4747 N. 7<sup>th</sup> Street, Phoenix, AZ 85014 (business) and 6546 E. 2<sup>nd</sup> St., Scottsdale, AZ 85251 (mailing).

3. On or about September 11, 2017, the Department issued to Respondent a license as an insurance producer, National Producer Number 18534432.

4. On November 6, 2017, the Department notified Respondent by mail at her address of record that her fingerprint card had been processed and returned by the Arizona Department of Public Safety (DPS) as illegible. The Department requested a replacement set

1 of fingerprints along with a completed "Illegible Fingerprint Replacement Form" on or before  
2 November 30, 2017. Respondent did not reply to the Department's request.

3 5. On March 2, 2018, the Department notified Respondent a second time by mail at  
4 her address of record that her fingerprints had been returned by DPS as illegible and that the  
5 Department was about to initiate an administrative action against her license for failure to  
6 comply with the fingerprint requirement. The Department requested a response by March 30,  
7 2018.

8 6. To date, Respondent has not submitted a full set of fingerprints to the  
9 Department.

#### 10 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

11 1. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.

12 2. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes the violation of the  
13 requirement that an applicant submit a full set of fingerprints to the Department within the  
14 meaning of A.R.S. § 20-285(E)(2).

15 3. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes the violation of any  
16 provision of A.R.S. Title 20 or any rule, subpoena or order of the director within the meaning of  
17 A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(2).

18 4. Grounds exist for the Director to suspend, revoke, or refuse to renew  
19 Respondent's insurance license, impose a civil penalty and/or order restitution pursuant to  
20 A.R.S. §§ 20-295(A) and (F).

3 1. Respondent may surrender her insurance producer license, National Producer  
4 Number **18534432**.

5 2. The hearing, Docket #18A-065-INS, scheduled for **December 6, 2018, at 1:00**  
6 **p.m.** is vacated.

20 4. Respondent acknowledges that the acceptance of this Consent Order by the  
21 Interim Director is solely to settle this matter against her and does not preclude any other  
22 agency, officer, or subdivision of this state including the Department from instituting civil or  
23 criminal proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future not related to this matter.

1           5.       Respondent acknowledges that this Consent Order is an administrative action  
2 that the Department will report to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners  
3 (NAIC). Respondent further acknowledges that she must report this administrative action to  
4 any and all states in which she holds an insurance license and must disclose this  
5 administrative action on any license application.


