CONSENT ORDER

The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that **HECTOR MARTINEZ JR** violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes. Hector Martinez Jr wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admit the following Findings of Fact are true and consent to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Hector Martinez Jr ("Martinez" or "Petitioner") is, and was at all material times licensed as an Arizona resident insurance producer, National Producer Number 9077483, with lines of authority in life, accident and health or sickness, property and casualty. Petitioner's insurance producer license expired on May 31, 2018.
- 2. On March 6, 2017, Petitioner pleaded guilty to and was convicted of Aggravated Assault, a class 3 felony, in the Superior Court of Arizona, Maricopa County, case number CR2016-143118. The Honorable Michael D. Gordon sentenced Petitioner to six months in jail and three years of probation.

- 3. Petitioner failed to notify the Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") within 30 days of his initial pretrial hearing date.
- 4. On May 16, 2018, Petitioner timely submitted a renewal application to the Department.
- On May 18, 2018, the Department notified Petitioner that it was refusing to renew his insurance producer license.
 - 6. On May 25, 2018, the Department received a timely appeal from Petitioner.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Interim Director has jurisdiction over this matter.
- 2. Petitioner's conduct, as described above, constitutes having been convicted of a felony, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(16).
- 3. Petitioner's conduct, as described above, constitutes violating any provision of this title or any rule, subpoena or order of the director, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(2).
- 4. Petitioner's conduct, as described above, constitutes failing to disclose within thirty days after the initial pretrial hearing date, any criminal prosecution taken in any jurisdiction, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-301(B).
- 5. Grounds exist for the Interim Director to deny, suspend, revoke, or refuse to renew Petitioner's insurance license, impose a civil penalty and/or order restitution pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-295(A) and (F).
- 6. The Interim Director may impose a civil penalty of not more than two hundred fifty dollars for each unintentional failure or violation, up to an aggregate civil penalty of two thousand five hundred dollars, or impose a civil penalty of not more than two thousand five

hundred dollars for each intentional failure or violation, up to an aggregate civil penalty of fifteen thousand dollars pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-295(F).

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- Hector Martinez Jr shall pay a civil penalty of two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00).
 Payment shall be due upon the submission of this Consent Order.
- 2. The Department shall renew the insurance producer license of Hector Martinez

 Jr., National Producer Number 9077483.
 - 3. The hearing scheduled for July 26, 2018 is vacated.
