**CONSENT ORDER**

**Petitioner.**

The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that **HECTOR MARTINEZ JR** violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes. Hector Martinez Jr wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admit the following Findings of Fact are true and consent to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Hector Martinez Jr ("Martinez" or "Petitioner") is, and was at all material times licensed as an Arizona resident insurance producer, National Producer Number 9077483, with lines of authority in life, accident and health or sickness, property and casualty. Petitioner's insurance producer license expired on May 31, 2018.

2. On March 6, 2017, Petitioner pleaded guilty to and was convicted of Aggravated Assault, a class 3 felony, in the Superior Court of Arizona, Maricopa County, case number CR2016-143118. The Honorable Michael D. Gordon sentenced Petitioner to six months in jail and three years of probation.



1 hundred dollars for each intentional failure or violation, up to an aggregate civil penalty of  
2 fifteen thousand dollars pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-295(F).

3 **ORDER**

4 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

5 1. Hector Martinez Jr shall pay a civil penalty of two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00).

6 Payment shall be due upon the submission of this Consent Order.

7 2. The Department shall renew the insurance producer license of Hector Martinez  
8 Jr., National Producer Number 9077483.

9 3. The hearing scheduled for July 26, 2018 is vacated.

3 Order and that he has entered into this Consent Order voluntarily.

4 5. Petitioner acknowledges that the acceptance of this Consent Order by the Interim  
5 Director is solely to settle this matter against him and does not preclude any other agency,  
6 officer, or subdivision of this state including the Department from instituting civil or criminal  
7 proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future not related to this matter.

8 6. Petitioner acknowledges that this Consent Order is an administrative action that  
9 the Department will report to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC).  
10 Petitioner further acknowledges that he must report this administrative action to any and all  
11 states in which he holds an insurance license and must disclose this administrative action on  
12 any license application.
