9 The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence
10 that **Matthew Joseph St. Martin (Respondent)** has violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona
11 Revised Statutes ("A.R.S."). Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the
12 commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Findings of Fact are true and
13 consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

14 **FINDINGS OF FACT**

15 1. Respondent is, and was at all material times, licensed as a resident insurance
16 producer with a lines of authority in accident and health or sickness and life insurance,
17 National Producer Number 2574161, which expires August 31, 2021.

18 2. Respondent's address of record with the Department is: 3144 East Fairfield St.,
19 Mesa, AZ 85213 (business and mailing).

20 3. On or about December 4, 2017, the Department issued to Respondent a license
21 as an insurance producer, National Producer Number 2574161.

22 4. On March 16, 2018, the Department notified Respondent by mail at his mailing
23 address of record that his fingerprint card had been processed and returned by the Arizona
24 Department of Public Safety (DPS) as illegible. The Department requested a replacement set

1 of fingerprints along with a completed "Illegible Fingerprint Replacement Form" on or before
2 April 6, 2018. Respondent did not reply to the Department's request.

3 5. On April 17, 2018, the Department notified Respondent a second time by mail at
4 his business address of record that his fingerprints had been returned by DPS as illegible and
5 that the Department was about to initiate an administrative action against his license for failure
6 to comply with the fingerprint requirement. The Department requested a response by May 4,
7 2018.

8 6. To date, Respondent has not submitted a full set of fingerprints to the
9 Department.

10 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

11 1. The Interim Director has jurisdiction over this matter.

12 2. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes the violation of the
13 requirement that an applicant submit a full set of fingerprints to the Department within the
14 meaning of A.R.S. § 20-285(E)(2).

15 3. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes providing incomplete
16 information in the license application within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(1).

17 4. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes the violation of any
18 provision of A.R.S. Title 20 or any rule, subpoena or order of the director within the meaning of
19 A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(2).

20 5. Grounds exist for the Interim Director to suspend, revoke, or refuse to renew
21 Respondent's insurance license, impose a civil penalty and/or order restitution pursuant to
22 A.R.S. §§ 20-295(A) and (F).

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
1 **ORDER**

2 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

3 1. Respondent shall immediately submit his fingerprints and an Illegible Fingerprint
4 Replacement Form to the Department.

5 2. Respondent shall pay a civil penalty of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) to the
6 Department, due upon the submission of this Consent Order.

14 1. Respondent has reviewed the foregoing Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law
15 and Order.

16 2. Respondent admits to the jurisdiction of the Interim Director of Insurance, State
17 of Arizona, and admits the foregoing Findings of Fact and consents to the entry of the
18 foregoing Conclusions of Law and Order.

19 3. Respondent is aware of his right to notice and a hearing at which he may be
20 represented by counsel, present evidence and examine witnesses. Respondent irrevocably
21 waives his right to such notice and hearing and to any court appeals relating to this Consent
22 Order.

1 4. Respondent states that no promise of any kind or nature whatsoever, except as
2 expressly contained in this Consent Order, was made to him to induce him to enter into this
3 Consent Order and that he has entered into this Consent Order voluntarily.

4 5. Respondent acknowledges that the acceptance of this Consent Order by the
5 Interim Director is solely to settle this matter against him and does not preclude any other
6 agency, officer, or subdivision of this state including the Department from instituting civil or
7 criminal proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future not related to this matter.

8 6. Respondent acknowledges that this Consent Order is an administrative action
9 that the Department will report to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners
10 (NAIC). Respondent further acknowledges that he must report this administrative action to
11 any and all states in which he holds an insurance license and must disclose this administrative
12 action on any license application.
