ORDER

Based upon reliable evidence provided to the Director of Insurance by the Assistant Director of the Financial Affairs Division of the Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department"), the Director finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Victoria Automobile Insurance Company ("Petitioner") is an Ohio domiciled insurance company that received its certificate of authority to transact property and casualty insurance in Arizona effective May 31, 1997.

2. Effective October 1, 2018, Petitioner, the non-surviving entity, merged into Victoria Fire & Casualty Company (VFCC), NAIC No. 42889, an Ohio domiciled insurer and the surviving entity. VFCC is authorized to transact insurance in Arizona. Petitioner voluntarily surrendered its certificate of authority to the Department.

3. The Insurance Commissioner of Ohio approved the merger of Petitioner into VFCC on July 23, 2018.

4. Petitioner has no outstanding obligations under any policy of insurance, whether written direct or through reinsurance ceded to it, to policyholders or claimants who are residents of this State.
