## **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

Petitioner has complied with the provisions of A.R.S. § 20-217, Title 20, Chapter 4, Article 14 and with A.A.C. R20-6-303 relating to the surrender of its Certificate of Authority and its withdrawal from the insurance business.

## **ORDER**

- 1. Petitioner's request to terminate its Certificate of Authority is granted.
- Petitioner may file its Articles of Dissolution with the Arizona Corporation
  Commission ("ACC").
- Petitioner shall provide the Department with the following: (a) an ACC certified copy of Petitioner's ACC filed Articles of Dissolution, and (b) the filing of the Petitioner's 2018 Annual Report.
- Petitioner shall pay its Certificate of Authority renewal fee to the Department unless it files Articles of Dissolution with the ACC on or before March 31, 2019.
- 5. The Department shall refund to the Petitioner the \$100.00 that was previously credited to the IERF pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-159.
