CONCLUSIONS OF LAW
 The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.
 Respondent's conduct, as described above, constitutes having been

convicted of a felony, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(6).

3. Respondent's conduct, as described above, constitutes failing, within thirty

days of the filing date of a criminal conviction in any jurisdiction, to report the criminal

Respondent failed to report the criminal conviction to the Department

conviction to the Director, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-301(B).

4. Respondent's conduct, as described above, constitutes a violation of any provision of Title 20, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(2).

5. Grounds exist for the Interim Director to suspend for not more than twelve months or revoke Respondent's insurance producer license, pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-295(A).

6. Grounds exist, in addition to or instead of any suspension, revocation or refusal to renew a license, for the Director to impose a civil penalty of not more than \$250.00 for each unintentional failure or violation, up to an aggregate civil penalty of \$2,500.00, or impose a civil penalty of not more than \$2,500.00 for each intentional failure or violation, up to an aggregate penalty of \$15,000.00, pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-295(F).

#### **ORDER**

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

 Nathan James Berger, National Producer Number 18686397, shall immediately pay a civil money penalty of \$500.00 for deposit into the State General Fund.
