CONSENT ORDER

Respondent.

The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that **Zachariah Scott Vickery** ("**Respondent**") violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes. Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Finding of Fact are true, and consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent is, and was at all material times, licensed as an Arizona resident insurance producer with a lines of authority in personal lines insurance, National Producer Number 18425285. Respondent's license expires on February 28, 2021.

2. Respondent's addresses of record with the Department are: 4215 E. McDowell Rd., Ste. 105, Mesa, AZ 85215 (business), 1123 N 88th Pl. Mesa, AZ 85207. (mailing) and zwick66@gmail.com (business e-mail).

3. On or about October 22, 2018, the Superior Court of Arizona, Maricopa County in State of Arizona v. Zachariah Scott Vickery, Case No. CR2018-115251 convicted Respondent of Theft, a class 6 undesignated felony.

1 4. Respondent failed to report the criminal conviction to the Department
2 within thirty days.

3 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

4 1. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.

5 2. Respondent's conduct, as described above, constitutes having been
6 convicted of a felony, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(6).

7 3. Respondent's conduct, as described above, constitutes failing, within thirty
8 days of the filing date of a criminal conviction in any jurisdiction, to report the criminal
9 conviction to the Director, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-301(B).

10 4. Respondent's conduct, as described above, constitutes a violation of any
11 provision of Title 20, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(2).


12 5. Grounds exist for the Interim Director to suspend for not more than twelve
13 months or revoke Respondent's insurance producer license, pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-
14 295(A).

15 **ORDER**

16 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

17 1. The Arizona resident insurance producer license of Zachariah Scott
18 Vickery, National Producer Number 18425285, is revoked effective immediately.

10 any court appeals relating to this Consent Order.


11 5. Respondent states that no promise of any kind or nature whatsoever,

14 6. Respondent acknowledges that the acceptance of this Consent Order by
15 the Director is solely to settle this matter against him and does not preclude any other
16 agency, officer, or subdivision of this state including the Department from instituting civil
17 or criminal proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future not related to this
18 matter.

20 7. Respondent acknowledges that this Consent Order is an administrative
21 action that the Department will report to the National Association of Insurance
22 Commissioners (NAIC). Respondent further acknowledges that he must report this
