No. 19A-018-INS CONSENT ORDER

The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that **Angela Maria Mansell ("Respondent")** violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes. Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Finding of Fact are true, and consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Respondent is, and was at all material times, licensed as an Arizona resident insurance producer with a lines of authority in property, casualty and personal lines insurance, National Producer Number 8358357. Respondent's license expires on July 31, 2022.
- 2. Respondent's addresses of record with the Department are: 40 Wantage Ave., Branchville, NJ 07890 (business) and 2116 E. Dolphin Ave., Mesa, AZ 85204-3735 (mailing) and ANGELA.MANSELL@SELECTIVE.COM (business e-mail).
- 3. On November 6, 2018, Respondent submitted an application for an Arizona insurance producer license ("Application") to the Department.
- 4. In the Application, under Background Questions, Respondent answered "Yes" to the following question:

1A. "Have you ever been convicted of a misdemeanor, had a judgment withheld or deferred, or are you currently charged with committing a misdemeanor? You may exclude the following misdemeanor convictions or pending misdemeanor charges: traffic citations, driving while under the influence (DUI), driving while intoxicated (DWI), driving without a license, reckless driving, or driving with a suspended or revoked license. You may also exclude juvenile adjudications (offenses where you were adjudicated delinquent in a juvenile court).

- 5. Respondent included an explanation of her "Yes" answer to Question 1A which stated: "I am not sure I answered the question correctly. Background question 1A I had a small judgment back in the 90s for an old medical bill, around \$500. I no longer have the documents as judgment was satisfied and has long cleared my credit report. I had a wage garnishment as a result that was satisfied. I cannot recall the debt collector as this was over 20 years ago. "
- 6. The Federal Bureau of Investigations conducted a criminal history check of Respondent's fingerprint card and notified the Department that Respondent had the following conviction:
 - a. April 08, 1998, Virginia Norfolk Circuit Criminal Division, Case No. CR98000453-00, Embezzlement 18.2-111¹;

¹Code of Virginia, § 18.2-111 reads, in pertinent part: "If any person wrongfully and fraudulently use, dispose of, conceal or embezzle any money, bill, note, check, order, draft, bond, receipt, bill of lading or any other person property, tangible or intangible, which he shall have received for another or for his employer, principal or bailor, or by virtue of his office, trust, or employment, or which shall have been entrusted or delivered

7. Respondent answered "Yes" to the Attestation section of the Application.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.
- 2. Respondent's conduct, as described above, constitutes providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete or materially untrue information in the license application, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(1).
- 3. Grounds exist for the Interim Director to suspend for not more than twelve months or revoke Respondent's insurance producer license, pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-295(A).
- 4. Grounds exist, in addition to or instead of any suspension, revocation or refusal to renew a license, for the Director to impose a civil penalty of not more than \$250.00 for each unintentional failure or violation, up to an aggregate civil penalty of \$2,500.00, or impose a civil penalty of not more than \$2,500.00 for each intentional failure or violation, up to an aggregate penalty of \$15,000.00, pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-295(F).

to him by another or by any court, corporation or company, he shall be guilty of embezzlement."

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

Angela Maria Mansell, National Producer Number 8358357, shall immediately pay a civil money penalty of \$100.00 for deposit into the State General Fund.

CONSENT TO ORDER

- Respondent has reviewed the foregoing Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.
- 2. Respondent admits to the jurisdiction of the Interim Director of Insurance, State of Arizona, and admits the foregoing Findings of Fact and consents to the entry of the foregoing Conclusions of Law and Order.
- 3. Respondent is aware of her right to notice and a hearing at which she may be represented by counsel, present evidence and examine witnesses.
- 4. Respondent irrevocably waives her right to such notice and hearing and to any court appeals relating to this Consent Order.
- 5. Respondent states that no promise of any kind or nature whatsoever, except as expressly contained in this Consent Order, was made to induce her to enter into this Consent Order and that she has entered into this Consent Order voluntarily.
- 6. Respondent acknowledges that the acceptance of this Consent Order by the Director is solely to settle this matter against her and does not preclude any other
