CONSENT ORDER

The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that Jason Adams Roque ("Respondent") violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes. Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- Jason Adams Roque ("Roque") is, and was at all material times, licensed as an 1. Arizona resident bail bond agent, Arizona license number 17570622, which expires on June 30, 2022.
- Roque's address of record is: c/o Alliance Bail Bond Services, 1013 S Stapley Dr, 2. Mesa, AZ, 85204 (business and mailing) and ALLIANCEBAILBONDS2016@GMAIL.COM.
 - Roque's license expired on June 30, 2018. 3.
- 4. From on or about June 30, 2018 through December 12, 2018, Roque sold, solicited, and negotiated at least eight (8) bail bond transactions.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.
- 2. Rogue's conduct, as described above, constitutes acting as a bail bond agent within this State without being licensed by the Director, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-340.01(A).
- 3. Roque's conduct, as described above, constitutes a violation of Title 20, within the meaning of A.R.S. §§ 20-295(A)(2) as applied to bail bond agents under A.R.S. §§ 20-340.06.
- 4. Grounds exist for the Director, in addition to or instead of any suspension, revocation or refusal to renew, impose a civil penalty of not more than two hundred fifty dollars for each unintentional failure or violation, up to an aggregate civil penalty of two thousand five hundred dollars, or impose a civil penalty of not more than two thousand five hundred dollars for each intentional failure or violation, up to an aggregate civil penalty of fifteen thousand dollars, within the meaning of A.R.S. §§ 20-295(F).

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

Respondent shall immediately pay a civil penalty of \$800.00 for deposit into the 1. State General Fund.

Respondent acknowledges that this Consent Order is an administrative action that the Department will report to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC) and that he may have to report this administrative action on any future licensing applications either to the Department or other states' Departments of Insurance.
