CONSENT ORDER

The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that Tony Ann Randolph, Ralph Cooper Randolph, Kelby Reese Randolph and Randolph & CO Bail Bonds Inc. (collectively "the Respondents") violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes. Respondents wish to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admit the following Findings of

FINDINGS OF FACT

Fact are true and consent to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

- Tony Ann Randolph ("Tony Ann") is, and was at all material times, licensed as an Arizona resident bail bond agent, National Producer Number 7542841, which expires July 31, 2020.
- Ralph Cooper Randolph ("Ralph") is, and was at all material times, licensed as an Arizona resident bail bond agent, National Producer Number 7541635, which expires July 31, 2020.

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- Kelby Reese Randolph ("Kelby") is, and was at all material times, licensed as an Arizona resident bail bond agent, National Producer Number 7763663, which expired on December 31, 2016.
- Randolph & CO Bail Bonds Inc., ("Randolph Bail Bonds") is, and was at all material times, licensed as an Arizona resident bail bond agent, Arizona license number 1800002542, which expired January 31, 2019.
- Respondents' address of record is: 49 South Mesa Drive, Mesa AZ 85210 (business and mailing).
 - 6. Tony Ann is the President and a shareholder of Randolph Bail Bonds.
 - 7. Kelby is the Vice President and shareholder of Randolph Bail Bonds.
 - 8. Ralph is Director of Randolph Bail Bonds¹.

Business License

- 9. On or about January 28, 2019, the Department conducted a field visit to the office of Respondents to serve a subpoena for documents related to a complaint.
 - 10. Respondents did not occupy their business/mailing address of record.
- Okland, a construction company had taken over usage of the Respondents business/mailing address of record since July of 2018.
- Respondents failed to notify the Department of their change of address within 30 days.
 - 13. Respondents failed to respond to the Department's subpoena.

¹ Information on officers and members from the Arizona Corporation Commission website. Respondents have reported Tony Ann and Kelby as President and Vice President of Randolph Bail Bonds, respectively, to the Department.

 Kelby informed the Department that Respondents relocated to New Mexico and sold their business to another licensed bail bond agent.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.
- 2. Respondents' conduct, as alleged above, constitutes a violation of any provision of Title 20 or any rule, subpoena or order of the Director, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(2) as applied to bail bond agents under A.R.S. § 20-340.06.
- 3. Respondents' conduct, as alleged above, constitutes failure to inform the Director, within 30 days, of any change in the licensee's residential, business or e-mail address, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-286(C)(1) as applied to bail bond agents under A.R.S. § 20-340.06.
- 4. Respondents' conduct, as alleged above, constitutes failure to have and maintain a place of business in this state that is accessible to the public and where the bail bond agent principally conducts transactions under the agent's license, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-340.01(E).
- Randolph Bail Bonds conduct, as alleged above, constitutes failure to have each owner and shareholder individually licensed as a bail bond agent, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-340.01(C).
- Grounds exist for the Director to suspend for not more than twelve months,
 revoke or refuse to renew Respondent's insurance licenses pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-295(A) as applied to bail bond agents under A.R.S. § 20-340.06.
- 7. On the written request of a person who is licensed, the Director may accept the surrender of the person's authority to transact one or more lines of insurance or of the person's entire license. A person who surrenders an authority or license shall not

reapply for the same authority or license for at least one year after the date of the surrender. A.R.S. § 20-289(F) as applied to bail bond agents under A.R.S. § 20-340.06.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

Respondents Tony Ann Randolph and Ralph Cooper Randolph submit Form L-SURR to surrender their bail bond agent licenses.
