### FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Respondent is, and was at all material times, licensed as an Arizona resident insurance producer with a lines of authority in personal lines insurance, National Producer Number 18725643. Respondent's license expires on May 31, 2021.
- 2. Respondent's addresses of record with the Department are: 8888 East Raintree Drive, Scottsdale, Arizona 85260 (business), 10255 East Via Linda, Unit 2014, Scottsdale, Arizona 85258 (mailing) and Blake. Kelley@thehartford.com (business email).
- 3. On or about September 14, 2018, the Superior Court of Arizona, Maricopa County in State of Arizona v. Blake Kelley, Case No. CR2017-002083 convicted Respondent of Forgery, a class 4 felony and Criminal Trespass in the First Degree, a class 6 undesignated felony.

11	provision of	Title 20, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(2).				
12	5.	Grounds exist for the Director to suspend for not more than twelve months				
13	or revoke R	espondent's insurance producer license, pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-295(A).
