CONSENT ORDER

The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that **David Kay Stewart** ("Stewart" or "Respondent") violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S."). Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings and admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Stewart was, at all material times, licensed as an Arizona resident insurance producer. On April 20, 1971, the Department issued Stewart a license, number 1034838¹, with two (2) lines of authority: accident and health or sickness, and life insurance. Stewart's license last renewed effective May 1, 2017 and is currently scheduled to expire on April 30, 2021.

¹ Effective 04/21/2017, the license number issued to each Arizona-licensed insurance professional changed to match the producer's National Producer Number ("NPN"). Stewart's former Arizona license number, now known as the Legacy License ID Number, is 3054.


1 3. Respondent is aware of his right to notice and to a hearing, at which he may be
2 represented by counsel, present evidence and examine witnesses. Respondent irrevocably
3 waives his right to such notice and hearing and to any court appeals relating to this Consent
4 Order.

5 4. Respondent states that no promise of any kind or nature whatsoever, except as
6 expressly contained in this Consent Order, was made to him to induce him to enter into this
7 Consent Order and that he has entered into this Consent Order voluntarily.

8 5. Respondent acknowledges that the acceptance of this Consent Order by the
9 Director is solely to settle this matter against him and does not preclude any other agency,
10 officer, or subdivision of this state including the Department from instituting civil or criminal
11 proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future.

12 6. Respondent acknowledges that this Consent Order is an administrative action
13 that the Department will report to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC)
14 and that he may have to report this administrative action on any future licensing applications
15 either to the Department or other states' Departments of Insurance.
