CONSENT ORDER

Respondent.

The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that Robert Arthur Contreras ("Contreras" or "Respondent") violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S."). Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Contreras was, at all material times, licensed as an Arizona resident property and casualty insurance producer. The Department issued Contreras license, number 101885011, on January 23, 2008. Contreras renewed the license on September 1, 2019 and it is scheduled to expire on July 31, 2023.
- 2. Contreras' addresses of record are: 2607 South 4th Avenue, Ste C3, Yuma, Arizona 85364-7371 (business); 340 West 32nd Street #235, Yuma, Arizona 85366 (mailing); and contrerasinsyuma@gmail.com (business email).

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Legacy Insurance Services Complaint

- 3. On or about August 21, 2019, Legacy Insurance Services, Inc. ("Legacy") submitted a complaint to the Department advising that Contreras's appointment with them was "Terminated for Cause" for misuse of policy funds.
- 4. Legacy alleged that between June 20, 2019 and July 11, 2019, Contreras received cash premium payments from four separate consumers but did not apply the money to their policies. Legacy provided cash receipts for each payment alleging that they originated from Contreras.
- Legacy advised that Contreras had since remitted all outstanding payments to them and all affected policies remain in force.
- 6. On or about November 5, 2019, the Department conducted an Examination Under Oath ("EUO") with Contreras who confirmed he contracted policies for the four consumers named in Legacy's complaint.
- 7. During the EUO, Contreras confirmed the cash payment receipts provided from Legacy originated from his office. Contreras was unable to explain why these payments were not applied to the respective policies.
- 8. Contreras confirmed that he remitted payment to Legacy for all outstanding premiums owed.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Director ("Director") has jurisdiction over this matter.
- 2. Contreras' conduct, as described above, constitutes improperly withholding, misappropriating or converting any monies received in the course of doing insurance business, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(4).

1	3. Contreras conduct, as described above, constitutes a demonstration of
2	incompetence, untrustworthiness or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business in this
3	state, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(8).
4	4. Grounds exist for the Director to deny, suspend for not more than twelve months,
5	revoke or refuse to renew the insurance producer's license, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-
6	295(A).
7	ORDER
8	IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:
9	The producer license for, Robert Arthur Contreras, National Producer Number
10	10188501, is revoked, effective immediately.
