**CONSENT ORDER** 

The Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that Gary Wade Lovell ("Lovell" or "Respondent") violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the Revised Statutes ("A.R.S"). commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Finding of Fact are true, and consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

#### FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Lovell is, and was at all material times, licensed as an Arizona non-resident insurance producer with lines of authority in life and accident and health or sickness, National Producer Number 829740. The Department issued the license to Lovell on December 18, 2015, which was last renewed on March 1, 2019 and it is scheduled to expire on February 28, 2023. Lovell's home state is Tennessee.
- 2. Lovell's addresses of record with the Department are: AFLAC, 1932 Wynnton Road, Suite 107, Columbus, Georgia 31999-0001 (business); P.O. Box 682146, Franklin, Tennessee, 37068-2146 (mailing). Lovell's business e-mail address of record with the Department is gary lovell@us.aflac.com.

Failure to Report

- 3. On or about August 16, 2019, The Indiana Commissioner of Insurance ("Indiana") suspended Lovell's Indiana non-resident producer's license for failing to provide his list of appointments within ten days. Indiana subsequently sent notification of this action to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC).
- Lovell failed to notify the Director within thirty days of this administrative 4. action.

### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- The Director has jurisdiction over this matter. 1.
- 2. Respondent's conduct, as described above, constitutes a violation of Title 20 or any rule, subpoena or order of the Director, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(2).
- 3. Respondent's conduct, as described above, constitutes failure to notify the director within thirty days after the final disposition of the matter of any administrative action taken against the producer in another jurisdiction, in violation of A.R.S. § 20-301(A).
- 4. Grounds exist for the Director to suspend for not more than twelve months or revoke Respondent's insurance producer license, pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-295(A).
- 5. Grounds exist, in addition to or instead of any suspension or revocation, for the Director to impose a civil penalty of not more than \$250 dollars for each unintentional failure or violation, up to an aggregate civil penalty of \$2500, or impose a civil penalty of not more than \$2500 for each intentional failure or violation, up to an aggregate civil penalty of \$15,000, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(F).

#### IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

Gary Wade Lovell, National Producer Number 829740, shall immediately pay a civil fine of \$250 for deposit into the state general fund.

Respondent acknowledges that this Consent Order is an administrative action that the Department will report to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners 6 7 (NAIC). Respondent further acknowledges that he must report this administrative action to 8 any and all states in which he holds an insurance license and must disclose this 9 administrative action on any license application.
