CONSENT ORDER

In the Matter of:

THOMPSON, JEFFREY FRANCIS

(National Producer No. 6732506)

Respondent.

The Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that **Jeffrey Francis Thompson ("Respondent")** violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S"). Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Finding of Fact are true, and consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Respondent is, and was at all material times, licensed in Arizona as a non-resident insurance producer, National Producer Number 6732506, with a line of authority in life insurance. Respondent's license is scheduled to expire on September 30, 2021.
- 2. Respondent's business and mailing address of record with the Department is 1979 West Littleton Boulevard, Littleton, CO 80120. Respondent's e-mail address of record with the Department is jfthompson44@gmail.com.

Complaint

3. The Department received and investigated a complaint regarding Respondent's license status in his resident state. The Department's investigation found the following:

<u>Colorado Insurance Licensure</u>

4. The Respondent's "State Licensing Report" published on the National Association of Insurance Commissioners' ("NAIC") website confirmed that the Respondent's resident state is Colorado. On September 30, 2019, Respondent's resident license was placed on "inactive status" due to Respondent's failure to renew his license.

Colorado Investment Adviser License Administrative Actions

- 5. On November 16, 2018, the Securities Commissioner State of Colorado issued a stipulated agreement under which Respondent agreed to summarily suspend his investment adviser license.
- 6. On February 13, 2019, the Securities Commissioner State of Colorado permanently relinquished Respondent's investment adviser license after Respondent entered into a consent order with the Commissioner.
- 7. On April 4, 2019, Respondent reported both Colorado actions to the Department, more than 30 days after the final order was entered in those cases.

Securities and Exchange Commission Action

8. On or about May 9, 2019 the United States Securities and Exchange Commission ("Commission") ordered a permanent bar against Respondent acting as an investment adviser, broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, municipal advisor, transfer agent, or nationally recognized statistical rating organization. The Commissioner's order stemmed from the Colorado action revoking Respondent's investment adviser license. Respondent failed to report this action to the Department.

Nebraska Insurance License

9. On May 30, 2019, the Nebraska Department of Insurance revoked Respondent's non-resident insurance license. The order made findings that Respondent failed to notify the Nebraska Department of Insurance of his Colorado license relinquishment.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.
- 2. Respondent's conduct, as described above, constitutes violating any provision of this title or any rule, subpoena or order of the Director, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(2).
- 3. Respondent, a nonresident insurance producer, is not currently licensed in his home state, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-287(A)(1).
- 4. Respondent's conduct, as described above, constitutes failure to notify the Director within thirty days after final disposition of any administrative action taken against the producer in another jurisdiction, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-301(A).
- 5. Respondent's conduct, as described above, constitutes having an insurance producer license, or its equivalent, denied, suspended, or revoked in any state, province, district or territory, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(9).
- 6. Grounds exist for the Director to suspend for not more than twelve months or revoke Respondent's insurance producer license, pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-295(A).

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ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The insurance producer license of Jeffrey Francis Thompson, National Producer Number 6732506, is revoked, effective immediately.

- 4. Respondent irrevocably waives his right to such notice and hearing and to any court appeals relating to this Consent Order.
- 5. Respondent states that no promise of any kind or nature whatsoever, except as expressly contained in this Consent Order, was made to induce him to enter into this Consent Order and that he has entered into this Consent Order voluntarily.

- 6. Respondent acknowledges that the acceptance of this Consent Order by the Director is solely to settle this matter against him and does not preclude any other agency, officer, or subdivision of this state including the Department from instituting civil or criminal proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future not related to this matter.
- 7. Respondent acknowledges that this Consent Order is an administrative action that the Department will report to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC). Respondent further acknowledges that he must report this administrative action to any and all states in which he holds an insurance license and must disclose this administrative action on any license application.
