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The Arizona Department of Insurance and Financial Institutions ("Department") has received evidence that Nathan Beeson ("Beeson") and Healthcare Solutions, LLC ("Healthcare") or (collectively "Respondents") violated provisions of Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S.") Title 20. Respondents wish to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admit the following Findings of Fact are true, and consent to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

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FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Beeson was at all material times licensed as an Arizona non-resident insurance producer, National Producer Number 18226231, with lines of authority in accident and health or sickness and life insurance. The Department first licensed Beeson on March 17, 2017. Beeson's license is scheduled to expire on October 31, 2024.
 - 2. Beeson's addresses of record with the Department are 136 W. 12300S, #200,

Draper, Utah 84020 (business); and 305 Foster St, Ste 201, Littleton, Massachusetts 01460-2021 (mailing).

- 3. Healthcare was at all material times licensed as an Arizona non-resident insurance producer, National Producer Number 19376041, with lines of authority in accident and health or sickens and life insurance. The Department first licensed Healthcare on February 25, 2020. Healthcare's license is scheduled to expire on February 29, 2024.
- 4. Healthcare's addresses of record with the Department are 136 W. 12300 S., Ste 201, Draper, Utah 84020 (business), and 30 N. Gould St., Ste. R, Sheridan, Wyoming 82801 (mailing).
 - 5. Beeson is the designated responsible producer ("DRP") for Healthcare.
- 6. On or about January 12, 2023, the Department received a Notice of Termination from the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services ("CMS") stating Beeson's "resident license in Wyoming has been suspended, terminated, or revoked. Accordingly, CMS is terminating [his] PY 2023 FFE Agreements and registration for cause."
- 7. The Department commenced an investigation into this matter. The investigation determined the following:
 - a) On or about September 21, 2022, the Department of Insurance, State of Wyoming, issued a Default Order, Docket No. 21-35, against Beeson revoking his Wyoming non-resident insurance producer license and imposing a civil money penalty against him. Beeson failed to report this action to the Department.
 - b) On or about October 27, 2022, the Department of Insurance, State of Wyoming, issued a Stipulation for Consent Order, Docket No. 21-36, against Beeson and

Healthcare by which Healthcare agreed to "terminate the resident producer firm license" as a consequence of Beeson's license being revoked in September 2022, and Healthcare inability to conduct insurance business in Wyoming without a DRP. Healthcare failed to report this action to the Department.

- c) On or about November 4, 2022, the Department of Insurance, State of Wyoming, issued a Motion to Adopt Stipulation for Consent Order, Docket No. 21-36, adopting the Stipulation for Consent Order, issued October 27, 2022, as an Order of the Commissioner.
- d) On or about November 4, 2022, the Department of Insurance, State of Wyoming issued a Consent Order, Docket No. 21-36, approving the Stipulation for Consent Order dated the 27th day of October, 2022, and adopting it as "an order of the Commissioner."
- e) On or about October 18, 2022, the Utah Insurance Commissioner, issued a Notice of Agency Action and Order, Docket No. 2022-4402, against Respondents revoking Beeson's Utah resident insurance producer licenses number 598468 and 888903 (inactive), and also revoking Healthcare's Utah non-resident insurance producer license number 855465. Respondents failed to report this action to the Department within the 30-day deadline.
- f) On or about December 1, 2022, the Utah Insurance Commissioner, issued a Notice of Agency Action, Docket No. 2022-4447, against Healthcare revoking its Utah "resident producer organization license number 758278." Healthcare failed to report this action to the Department within the 30-day deadline.

Furthermore, and notwithstanding any language in this Consent Order, this Consent Order does not preclude in any way any other state agency or officer or political subdivision of this state from instituting proceedings, investigating claims, or taking legal action as may be appropriate now or in the future relating to this matter or other matters concerning Respondent, including but not limited to violations of Arizona's Consumer Fraud Act. Respondent acknowledges that, other than with respect to the Department, this Consent Order makes no representations, implied or otherwise, about the views or intended actions of any other state agency or officer or political subdivision of the state relating to this matter or other matters concerning Respondent.
