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The Arizona Department of Insurance and Financial Institutions ("Department") alleges that Mohave Transportation Insurance Company ("Respondent") violated provisions of Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S.") Title 20. Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Findings of Fact are true, and consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Respondent is an Arizona domiciled captive insurer. Respondent holds a certificate of authority, with a line of business in casualty with workers' compensation insurance, issued by the Department on June 13, 2006.
- 2. During 2022, the Department received two Arizona consumers' complaints alleging various misconducts by Respondent.
 - 3. The Department investigated the allegations and found the following:

Complaint Number 50064

 a) On or about August 30, 2022, A.P. submitted a complaint to the Department alleging that Respondent delayed processing her vehicle claim.

- b) On or about September 1, 2022, the Department called Respondent at Respondent's number on file with the Department (800-491-8421) to inquire about A.P.'s claim. The Department's representative left a voicemail requesting a callback.
- c) On or about October 14, 2022, the Department called Misti Ramirez (Ms. Ramirez"), the Co-Founder and Chief Operating Officer of Em Anderson Risk Services, Respondent's Claim Administrator, to inquire about A.P.'s claim. The Department's representative left a voicemail requesting a callback.
- d) On or about November 8, 2022, the Department, via email correspondence sent to mramirez@emariskservices.com, requested that Respondent provide complete records and a response to A.P.'s complaint by November 15, 2022. Respondent failed to respond.
- e) On or about December 22, 2022, the Department sent a second email correspondence to mramirez@emariskservices.com requesting a response by December 30, 2022. Respondent failed to respond.
- f) On or about January 10, 2023, the Department called Ms. Ramirez at the telephone number 210-540-9168. The Department's representative received a recorded message stating, Respondent "is experiencing system problems."
- g) On or about February 3, 2023, the Department again contacted Ms. Ramirez at the same telephone number. The Department's representative received a recorded message stating, Respondent "is experiencing system problems."
- h) On or about March 25, 2023, the Department sent a third email correspondence to mramirez@emariskservices.com requesting a response by March 30, 2023. Respondent provided a response on March 30, 2023.

Complaint Number 50945

i) On or about November 2, 2022, C.L. submitted a complaint to the Department alleging that Respondent failed to return his multiple communications relating to a vehicle claim.

- j) On or about November 8, 2022, the Department, via email correspondence sent to mramirez@emariskservices.com, requested that Respondent provide complete records and a response regarding C.L.'s complaint by November 15, 2022. Respondent failed to respond.
- k) On or about March 28, 2023, the Department sent a second email correspondence to mramirez@emariskservices.com requesting a response to April 3, 2023. Respondent provided a late response on April 12, 2023.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 4. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.
- 5. The Director has authority to conduct examinations and investigations of insurance matters and to request the accounts, records, documents, files, assets and matters in the person's possession or control pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-142(C).
- 6. The director may after a hearing refuse to renew or may revoke or suspend an insurer's certificate of authority, if the insurer violates the provisions of Title 20. A.R.S. § 20-220(A)(1).
- 7. In lieu of or in addition to suspension or revocation, the Director may impose a penalty not to exceed one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) for each violation and not to exceed an aggregate of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) within any six-month period with respect to unintentional violations. A.R.S. § 20-220(B)(1).

ORDER IT IS ORDERED: 8. Respondent shall immediately pay to the Department a civil money penalty in the amount of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00). 9. Respondent shall provide to the Department all requested documents and information upon execution of this Consent Order. 10. Respondent shall provide timely and complete responses to any future inquiries by the Department unless a written request for an extension is approved by the Department prior to the deadline. Respondent acknowledges and agrees that the acceptance of this Consent to Order by the Director is solely to settle this matter and does not preclude the Department from instituting other proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future. Furthermore, and notwithstanding any language in this Consent Order, this Consent Order does not preclude in any way any other state agency or officer or political subdivision of this state from instituting proceedings, investigating claims, or taking legal action as may be appropriate now or in the future relating to this matter or other matters concerning Respondent, including but not limited to violations of Arizona's Consumer Fraud Act. Respondent acknowledges that, other than with respect to the Department, this Consent Order makes no representations, implied or otherwise, about the views or intended actions of any other state agency or officer or political subdivision of the state relating to this matter or other matters concerning Respondent.
- 5. Respondent acknowledges and agrees that failure to correct the violations set forth above in this Consent Order, or any repeat findings of the above violations in the future, can result in disciplinary action which may include a greater civil money penalty and suspension or revocation of its license.
