## FINDINGS OF FACT

- AXA Insurance Company ("Petitioner") is a New York domiciled insurance company that received its certificate of authority to transact property and casualty insurance in Arizona effective July 10, 1978.
- 2. Effective October 23, 2023, Petitioner, the non-surviving entity, merged into Coliseum Reinsurance Company (CRC), NAIC No. 36552, a Delaware domiciled insurer and the surviving entity. CRC is authorized to transact insurance in Arizona. Petitioner voluntarily surrendered its certificate of authority to the Department.
- The Insurance Commissioner of New York approved the merger of Petitioner into
   CRC on September 21, 2023.

1	4. Petitioner has no outstanding obligations under any policy of insurance, whether		
2	written direct or through reinsurance ceded to it, to policyholders or claimants who are		
3	residents of this State.		
4	5. Petitioner is not the subject of any pending investigation or market conduct		
5	examination and Petitioner does not owe this Department any filings or fees.		
6	6. Petitioner has a \$100.00 deposit with the Insurance Examiners' Revolving Fund		
7	("IERF").		
8	CONCLUSIONS OF LAW		
9	Petitioner has complied with the provisions of A.R.S. § 20-217 and with A.A.C. R20-6-		
10	303 relating to the surrender of its Certificate of Authority.

12	The surrender of the Petitioner's certificate of authority is accepted.

14	previously credited to the IERF pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-159.
