## **FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Woman's Life Insurance Society ("Petitioner") is a Michigan domiciled fraternal benefit society that received its certificate of authority to transact life insurance in Arizona effective February 1, 1914.

2. Effective September 1, 2024, Petitioner, the non-surviving entity, merged into Trusted Fraternal Life (TFL), NAIC No. 56030, a Wisconsin domiciled fraternal benefit society and the surviving entity. TFL is authorized to transact insurance in Arizona. Petitioner voluntarily surrendered its certificate of authority to the Department.

3. The Insurance Commissioner of Michigan approved the merger of Petitioner into TFL on June 26, 2024.
