1. Assured Guaranty Municipal Corp. ("Petitioner") is a New York domiciled insurance company that received its certificate of authority to transact casualty insurance in Arizona effective December 22, 1986.

Effective August 1, 2024, Petitioner, the non-surviving entity, merged into
 Assured Guaranty Inc. (AGI), NAIC No. 30180, a Maryland domiciled insurer and the surviving
 entity. AGI is authorized to transact insurance in Arizona. Petitioner voluntarily surrendered its
 certificate of authority to the Department.

3. The Insurance Commissioner of New York approved the merger of Petitioner into AGI on June 7, 2024.

2	written direct or through reinsurance ceded to it, to policyholders or claimants who are		
3	residents of this State.
