Based upon reliable evidence provided to the Director of Insurance and Financial Institutions by the Deputy Assistant Director of the Financial Affairs Division of the Arizona Department of Insurance and Financial Institutions ("Department"), the Department finds as follows:

## FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Athene Annuity & Life Assurance Company ("Petitioner") is a Delaware Domicile domiciled insurance company that received its certificate of authority to transact life and disability insurance in Arizona effective June 7, 1922.
- 2. Effective October 11, 2024, Petitioner, the non-surviving entity, merged into Athene Annuity and Life Company (AALC), NAIC No. 61689, an Iowa domiciled insurer and the surviving entity. AALC is authorized to transact insurance in Arizona. Petitioner voluntarily surrendered its certificate of authority to the Department.
- 3. The Insurance Commissioner of Delaware approved the merger of Petitioner into AALC on October 9, 2024.

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1	4. Petitioner has no outstanding obligations under any policy of insurance, whether	
2	written direct or through reinsurance ceded to it, to policyholders or claimants who are	
3	residents of this State.	
4	5. Petitioner is not the subject of any pending investigation or market conduct	
5	examination and Petitioner does not owe this Department any filings or fees.	
6	6. Petitioner has a \$100.00 deposit with the Insurance Examiners' Revolving Fund	
7	("IERF").	
8	CONCLUSIONS OF LAW	
9	Petitioner has complied with the provisions of A.R.S. § 20-217 and with A.A.C. R20-6-	
10	303 relating to the surrender of its Certificate of Authority.	
11	ORDER	
12	The surrender of the Petitioner's certificate of authority is accepted.	
13	2. The Department shall refund to the Petitioner the sum of \$100.00 that was	
14	previously credited to the IERF pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-159.
