In order to resolve the complaint pending before the Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department"), Respondent admits the Findings of Fact set forth herein as true and consents entry of the to following Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Respondent is licensed by the Arizona Department of Insurance as a Property and Casualty Insurance Agency, license number 611461.
- 2. about September 20, On or 1992, Respondent distributed advertising material which advertised Insurance Agency as being a member of the Arizona Guaranty Fund.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- The Department of Insurance has jurisdiction over 1. this matter.
- 2. . The above referenced conduct by the Respondent constitutes the transaction of insurance within the meaning of A.R.S. §20-106.
- 3. The above referenced conduct by the Respondent constitutes a violation of A.R.S. §20-443.6.
- A.R.S. §20-443(6) prohibits any person from using 4. the existence of the Arizona Guaranty Fund in the sale or attempted sale of any policy of insurance.
- 5. Grounds exist for the Director to suspend, revoke or refuse to renew Respondent's insurance license, and impose a civil penalty upon Respondent pursuant to A.R.S. §20-316(C).

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

- 1. Respondent shall cease and desist in the future from the advertisement of the existence of the Arizona Guaranty Fund in connection with the sale or attempted sale of any policy of insurance.
- Respondent shall pay a civil penalty in 2. the amount of \$250.00 to the Arizona Department of Insurance on or before thirty (30) days from the entry of this Order.

- 5. The undersigned hereby waives all rights to challenge the foregoing Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order, to appeal or otherwise, and agrees to be bound hereby.
- 6. The undersigned hereby swears he is empowered to act on behalf of the respondent in the acceptance of this Consent Order.
