- 3. Respondents will jointly and severally pay restitution in the amount of \$5,282.00 to Amwest Surety Insurance Company within 60 days of entry of the Director's Order and provide proof of such payment to the Department at the end of that 60 day period.

NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTS

The aggrieved party may request a rehearing with respect to this Order by filing a written petition with the

Office of Administrative Hearings within 30 days of the date of this Order, setting forth the basis for such relief pursuant to A.A.C. R20-6-114(B).

The final decision of the Director may be appealed to the Superior Court of Maricopa County for judicial review pursuant to A.R.S. §20-166.

RECOMMENDED DECISION OF ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE

ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE: Lewis D. Kowal

On June 4, 1996, the Director issued a Notice of Hearing (the "Notice") in the above-captioned matter.

The Notice required Respondents Pamela Michelle Miskin and Contractors Insurance Agency, Inc. ("Respondents") to provide a written answer to the allegations set forth in the Notice within twenty days of the issuance of the Notice. As of this date, Respondents have failed to file an answer. On July 9, 1996, counsel for the Department filed a Request for Default and Proposed Findings of Facts, Conclusions of Law and Recommended Order. As of this date, Respondents have not responded to the Department's request. Pursuant to A.A.C. R20-6-106(C), a party that fails to file an answer within the time provided shall be deemed to be in default and one or more of the allegations in the Notice of Hearing may be deemed to be admitted. Therefore, the hearing scheduled for this matter is vacated from the hearing calendar of the Office of Administrative Hearings.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Notice was proper.
- 2. Respondents are in default.
- 3. The allegations in the Notice are deemed admitted.

4. There having been no objection filed by Respondents regarding the amount of restitution recommended by the Department's counsel in the Proposed Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Proposed Order submitted to the Administrative Law Judge and mailed to Respondents, it is determined that Respondents have acquiesced to the Department's proposed restitution.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The conduct alleged in the Notice constitutes grounds for the Director to suspend, revoke or refuse to renew the Respondents' licenses to transact insurance in Arizona, within the meaning of A.R.S. §20-316(A).
- 2. The conduct alleged in the Notice constitutes grounds for the Director to impose a civil penalty and order restitution pursuant to A.R.S. §20-316(C).

RECOMMENDED ORDER

Based on the above, the undersigned Administrative Law Judge recommends that:

- 1. All insurance licenses held by Respondents Pamela Michelle Miskin and Contractors Insurance Agency, Inc. are revoked effective upon the issuance of the Director's Order.
- 2. Respondents jointly and severally pay restitution in the amount of \$5,282.00 to Amwest Surety Insurance Company within 60 days of entry of the Director's Order and provide proof of such payment to the Department at the end of that 60 day period.
