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On May 24, 1996, HealthPartners Health Plans, Inc. (Petitioner) filed with the Arizona Department of Insurance at 2910 North 44th Street, Suite 210, Phoenix, Arizona Articles of Merger and the Plan and Agreement of Merger whereby Samaritan Health Plan, Inc. (Insurer) will merge into Petitioner.

Based upon the entire filing in this matter, the Director makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and enters the following Order:

- 1. Insurer is duly qualified and authorized as a Health Care Services Organization in the State of Arizona.
- 2. Petitioner is duly qualified and authorized as a Health Care Services Organization in the State of Arizona.
- 3. No evidence has been produced that would indicate or form the basis for a finding that the Plan and Agreement of Merger heretofore filed would conclude that after the merger the Petitioner would not be able to satisfy the requirements for the reissuance of a Certificate of Authority.

4. The provisions of A.R.S. §20-1070 have been complied with and the companies are entitled to an Order by the Director of Insurance approving the Plan and Agreement of Merger filed in this matter.

5. The Department may have incurred examination expenses as a result of this merger.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, CHRIS HERSTAM, Director of Insurance of the State of Arizona, do hereby order:

- 1. The Plan and Agreement of Merger between the Insurer and the Petitioner is approved.
- 2. The statutory deposit of the Insurer in the amount of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000) and the Escrow Reserves Deposit in the amount One Million One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,100,000) shall be transferred to the accounts of the Petitioner upon receipt by the Department of Insurance of the following: (1) payment of examination expenses; (2) copies of the Articles of Merger of the Insurer and the Petitioner certified as filed by the Arizona Corporation Commission, but not until and unless accompanied by a copy of the official Arizona State Treasurer's receipt fully executed; and (3) a complete and satisfactory Plan for Risk of Insolvency.
- 3. The Petitioner shall promptly remit to the Insurance Examiners' Revolving Fund payment for expenses incurred as a result of this merger.
- 4. The sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100) heretofore credited to the Insurance Examiners' Revolving Fund shall be refunded to the Insurer pursuant to A.R.S. §20-159.

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5. The Insurer shall file its 1996 Annual Statement with the Department, together with all applicable fees, unless Insurer files its Plan of Merger pursuant to A.R.S. §10-1105 with the Arizona Corporation Commission prior to December 31, 1996 and returns a file-stamped copy to the Department.
