This matter regularly came on for hearing at the Department of Insurance at which hearing the Department was represented by Susan Gallinger, Assistant Attorney General. The Respondent did not appear at the hearing, either in person or by counsel. Evidence and testimony were submitted and it is found as follows:

1. At the time of the alleged violations, the Respondent was a licensed insurance agent.
2. In April, 1983 the Respondent received approximately fifteen hundred dollars (\$1,500) for aviation insurance from Milton Coggins.
3. The Respondent failed to forward the premium to either his general agent or the insurance company.
4. On or about December 13, 1983 the Respondent accepted one thousand ninety-five dollars (\$1,095) as an additional premium from Coggins.
5. The Respondent also failed to forward this premium to either his general agent or an insurance company.

Grounds exist to suspend or revoke the Respondent's insurance license for misappropriating or converting to his own use monies belonging to a policyholder in violation of A.R.S. § 20-316.

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IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED revoking the Respondent's license. The revocation of the license is effective December 20, 1985.

The Respondent may request a review or a rehearing of this matter by making such request in writing setting forth the grounds therefor and the relief requested within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.





PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that, pursuant to the provisions of A.R.S. §§ 20-161 through 20-165, the above-captioned matter will be heard before the Director of Insurance of the State of Arizona, or his duly designated representative on the 17th day of October, 1985, at 1:00 o'clock P.M., at 1601 West Jefferson Street, Fourth Floor, Phoenix, Arizona.

Motions to continue this matter shall be made in writing not less than five (5) business days prior to the date set for the Hearing.

A.R.S. § 20-164, entitles any person affected by such a hearing to appear in person and by counsel to be present during the giving of all evidence, to have a reasonable opportunity to inspect all documentary evidence to examine witnesses, to present evidence in support of its interest and to have subpoenas issued by the Director to compel attendance of witnesses and production of evidence in its behalf.

This hearing is being called by the Director because he is informed and has probable cause to believe that on or about April 4, 1983, Respondent accepted approximately
