FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Respondent is a resident of the State of Arizona and is licensed by the Arizona Department of Insurance as a resident insurance agent.
- 2. On or about April 16, 1985 the Respondent issued an unauthorized endorsement to a liability policy underwritten by Fremont Indemnity Company, Inc. for Simon, Reeves & Roberts, Attorneys at Law.
- 3. The Respondent issued the aforementioned endorsement to reduce the total premium from \$6,441 to \$3,817.60 to coincide with a prior misquote.

6. The Respondent issued the aforementioned endorsement to give the appearance of broadened coverage and to extend coverage an additional two years.

7. The unauthorized endorsement on the inland transit policy resulted in the loss of \$24,141 to the Olliver/Pilcher Insurance, Inc.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. Respondent, MICHAEL JOHN BERNAY, is in violation of A.R.S. § 20-316.A.7. (conduct of affairs under the license showing the licensee to be incompetent or a source of injury and loss to, or repeated complaint by, the public or any insurer).
- 2. Respondent, MICHAEL JOHN BERNAY, is in violation of A.R.S. § 20-443.1 (Misrepresenting the terms of any policy issued or the benefits and advantages promised or the dividends or share of the surplus to be received.)
- 3. Grounds exist for the Director to suspend, revoke, or refuse to renew Respondent's insurance license or to order Respondent to pay a monetary forfeiture or both, pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-316.C.
- 4. Grounds exist for the Director to order the Respondent to cease and desist from violating A.R.S. §§ 20-

1 316.A.7. and 20-443.1, for revocation of his insurance license or both. 3 ORDER 4 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, Respondent's insurance license is 5 revoked effective September 8, 1986. 6 4th day of September, 1986.
