FINDING OF FACTS

- Notice is proper in this case pursuant to A.R.S.
 \$\$\frac{41-1009}{6}\$ & 41-1013;
- 2. Jurisdiction is proper for this hearing pursuant to A.R.S. §41-1013;
- 3. At all times relevant hereto, Respondent was a licensed insurance agent with the State of Arizona;
- 4. In 1986, Respondent was convicted of four counts of aggravated assault, class 3 felonies, and five counts of endangerment, class 6 felonies;
- 5. On or about December, 1986, Respondent was sentenced by the Mohave County Superior Court, under cause number CR-8287, to 6 years on one count and 5 years on three counts of aggravated assault, with all aggravated assault counts to run concurrently, 1 1/2 years for each of the five counts of

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endangerment, with sentencing for the endangerment counts to 1 2 begin at the completion of the 6 years aggravated assault sentence, and was fined \$500.00. 4 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW 5 The herein-described conduct constitutes a record 6 of conviction by final judgment of felonies involving moral turpitude within the meaning of A.R.S. §20-316.A.6. 8 IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED: 9 That Respondent's license to transact insurance in the State of Arizona is hereby REVOKED; 10 11 2. Respondent may request a rehearing with respect to 12 this Order by filing a written petition with the Director within 13 30 days of the date of this Order, setting forth the basis for 14 such relief pursuant to A.R.S. §41-1010(B), and A.C.R.R.
