A Second Amended Notice of Hearing was issued by the Department on September 17, 1992 wherein the Department alleged Respondent violated the provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes. Respondent has received the Second Amended Notice and has been advised of his right to a hearing and hereby waives that right and agrees to the following consent order.

Therefore, the Director finds that the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law set forth herein are admitted and enters the following Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- l. Joseph Howard Bayne, Jr. ("Respondent") is presently, and was at all material times licensed as a nonresident life and disability insurance agent in the state of Arizona (License No. 0798895). Respondent's license will expire on December 31, 1993.
- 2. On or about July 1, 1990, Respondent submitted an application and a premium payment for an insurance policy for Earl Eppstein ("Eppstein") to American Travellers Insurance Co.

("American Travellers").

- 3. On or about July 13, 1990, American Travellers denied Eppstein's application for an insurance policy and issued Eppstein policy premium refund Check Number R 32262 in the amount of \$5,710.00 on or about July 23, 1990.
- 4. On or about July 23, 1990, American Travellers notified Respondent that a policy premium refund was issued to Eppstein and that Respondent should remit commission on the policy in the amount of \$3,436.00 to American Travellers.
- 5. On or about August 2, 1990, Respondent submitted a letter to American Travellers together with American Travellers Check Number R 32262 requesting that American Travellers reconsider Eppstein's application.
 - 6. On or about August 2, 1990, Eppstein died.

7. On or about November 5, 1990, American Travellers

- 8. On or about November 16, 1990, American Travellers issued Check Number R 47482 in the amount of \$5,710.00 to the estate of Eppstein. Check Number R 47482 was issued to replace Check Number R32262 which had been issued as a policy premium refund to Eppstein and which had been returned by Respondent.
- 9. On or about November 28, 1990, American Travellers notified Respondent that a premium refund was issued to Eppstein and that Respondent should remit commission in the amount of \$3,436.00 to American Travellers.
 - 10. Respondent had a general agents contract

("contract") with American Travellers, attached hereto as exhibit A.

11. Respondent's contract provided for the return of any monies accepted with an application American Travellers declined to issue a policy on, (contract p. 3, provision 11).

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Department of Insurance has jurisdiction over this matter.
- 2. Respondent's conduct described above constitutes a conduct of affairs under his license showing him to be incompetent or a source of injury and loss to the public or any insurer, in violation of A.R.S. § 20-316(A)(7).
- 3. Grounds exist for the Director to suspend, revoke or refuse to renew Respondent's insurance licenses and impose a civil penalty upon Respondent, pursuant to A.R.S. §§ 20-290(B), 20-316(A) and 20-316(C).

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. Respondent shall make restitution in the amount of \$3,436.00 to American Travellers within 120 days of the date of this order.

- 5. The undersigned hereby waives all right to challenge such Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order on appeal or otherwise, and agrees to be bound hereby.
