

Notice of Close of Record – Expedited Rulemaking

R20-6-401. Proxies, Consents, and Authorizations of Domestic Stock Insurers Close of Record on June 18, 2019

On May 17, 2019, the Arizona Department of Insurance (“Department”) published a Notice of Expedited Rulemaking in the Arizona Register, (25 A.A.R. 1220, May 17, 2019). The rulemaking proposed to amend R20-6-401 - Proxies, Consents, and Authorizations of Domestic Stock Insurers, to update the addresses for the Department and the National Association of Insurance Commissioners which are both referenced in the rule.

Under A.R.S. § 41-1027(A)(3), the Department may conduct an expedited rulemaking to correct typographical errors, make address or name changes or clarify the language of a rule without changing its effect. Pursuant to the statute, the Department delivered notices of the proposed expedited rulemaking to the governor, the president of the senate, the speaker of the house of representatives, the administrative rules oversight committee and to the Governor’s Regulatory Review Council. A.R.S. § 41-1027(B). The Department and GRRC also posted the proposed rulemaking on their respective websites as required by A.R.S. § 41-1027(C).

As of June 17, 2019, no one has requested an oral proceeding or posted a comment on the proposed changes to AAC R20-6-401. Therefore, the Department will close the record on **June 18, 2019**, and will submit the rulemaking to the Governor’s Regulatory Review Council (GRRC) to finalize the rule.
