

REINSURER ANNUAL INSTRUCTIONS

Accredited Reinsurer - Arizona Revised Statutes § 20-261.05(C) and Arizona Administrative Code R20-6-1602

Do the following:

- 1. Pay Certificate of Reinsurance Accreditation annual statement filing fee by March 1. Go to our website at https://insurance.az.gov/insurers/taxes for instructions and forms.
- 2. File annual statement electronically with the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC) by March 1.
- 3. File audited financial statement electronically with the NAIC by June 1.

Reinsurer Domiciled in Another State - Arizona Revised Statutes § 20-261.05(D) & (H) and Arizona Administrative Code R20-6-1603

No annual filings.

Reinsurer Maintaining Trust Funds - Arizona Revised Statutes § 20-261.05(E) & (H) and Arizona Administrative Code R20-6-1604

Do the following:

- 1. File annual statement electronically with the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC) by March 1.
- 2. File a report from the trustee setting forth the balance of the trust and listing the trust's investments at the preceding year-end and certifying the date of termination of the trust, if so planned, or certifying that the trust shall not expire prior to the following December 31 with the Arizona Department of Insurance by February 28.
- If applicable under Arizona Administrative Code R20-6-1604(B)(3)(i) or (ii) or Arizona Administrative Code R20-6-1604(B)(4)(d), file an annual certification of solvency with the Arizona Department of Insurance within 90 days after the financial statements are due to be filed with domiciliary regulator.
